Missional Focus: Mission Trips & Garden

Dear Anderson Church Family,

As we continue progressing through our Ministry calendar for 2015, two unique opportunities to work together are underway: mission trips and a community garden. I will share more about the Community Garden next week. This week I want to focus on our two mission trips—both of which are here in the United States. The first trip is scheduled for May 10-21 at Camp MiVoden. Situated in Northern Idaho in a beautiful area is this faithful camp. Each year they minister to the young and young at heart in a beautiful setting. However, with the amount of use they have comes much work to be done. Everything from yard work and painting to more involved projects is necessary to give them the boost they need for the coming season. Registration is already underway and so if you are in hopes of securing a spot on this trip see John Hansen as soon as possible!

A second trip that is being planned is to Milo Academy in Days Creek, Oregon. Years ago I was a cook in the cafeteria and enjoyed the campus immensely. However, with the continual use of the buildings and the limited staffing, they are also in need of a boost. That is where the Ultimate Workout project comes in June 17-28. This is for young people ages 13+ and it has a participation fee of \$475 each young person who goes. In addition to updates on the various buildings, there will be outreach projects that will involve helping members of the community with various projects and an outreach ministry at a local church.
