Missional Focus: Christ's Care Garden

Dear Anderson Church Family,

March will soon be upon us and the warmer season brings many outdoor tasks to accomplish before summer arrives. One task that is familiar to many of our members is gardening. The fresh breezes, the fragrant flowers, the smell of soil—all tell of the blessings of working in the 2nd Book of God: Nature.

One project that is coming up this week and next is the community garden. Our first steps are to mark off the boundaries of the raised beds, buy supplies and get the beds in. After the beds are in, the planting begins followed by a plan to fence in the back acreage. Many hours of work are ahead, and the Garden committee has done a great job of getting seeds, soliciting funds, and getting a preliminary budget approved. Also, the funds have been raised for most of the work to be done and the Northern California Conferences has given a generous subsidy of \$1,000.

The produce of the garden will benefit those who come to the Wednesday food distribution and will provide fresh produce for our weekly fellowship meals. However, spiritually we gain many blessings from working the soil. The Bible is full of agrarian analogies and parables linking us from the fundamentals of nature to the Kingdom of Heaven (see Genesis 2, Matthew 10, etc). Also, Ellen White states that Christ is the Heavenly Husbandman (Fundamentals of Christian Education, page 111), that lessons from nature teach us about Him (Education, pages 111-112) and lastly that we should educate people concerning gardening (Testimonies Volume 1 page 436, etc). It is the purpose of this ministry that Christ's Care for each soul will be seen and that the "graces of the character of Christ" will be revealed to His honor and glory (My Life Today, page 273). As we behold lessons from nature, may we see Christ's Care for us!
