

Pastor's Greeting: Local Stewardship

Dear Anderson Church Family,

This week we will spend some time focusing on our local church stewardship—what is also called *Church Family Budget*. There will be some details that most already know about, but other bits of information that may be new to you. For instance, did you know that only 30% of our budget goes to the upkeep of the building? The other 60% goes to some form of ministry in our church (this does not include the tithe that you return each month, all of that goes to the Conference and about 40% comes back in the form of pastoral salary/benefits). Here is a pie chart to illustrate:

Church Family Budget 2015




<u>Wages</u> are the costs of having a part time janitor, secretary and treasurer. <u>Expenses/reserves</u> are the utilities, office supplies, maintenance supplies, property taxes, insurance, savings, etc. <u>Education/ministry</u> includes our subsidy to Redding Adventist Academy, audio/visual supplies, fellowship meal supplies, socials, worthy student, various ministries and Sabbath School expenses. Our church has historically been very faithful in supporting our Family Budget—praise be to God! However, seeing how the funds are used can help us prayerfully consider future giving.
