Dear Anderson Church Family,

This week we will spend some time focusing on one of our Local Conference Offerings—what is also called *Conference Advance*. By way of reminder, we are part of the Northern California Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, a group of churches, schools and ministries that encompasses many cities and is comprised of almost 40,000 members. With such a huge territory and many needs, we team up together with this offering entitled Conference Advance. However, the question may come to mind: How is this offering used? Here is the list of categories that benefit from this offering:

85% Leoni Meadows Summer Camp Ministry

6% Inner City—Bridges and other large city initiatives

3% Nave American Ministries

3% K-12 Education to help subsidize our schools

3% Evangelism—which helps churches subsidize evangelistic meetings (like Landmarks of Prophecy) by providing 2/3 of the cost of each series of meetings. We have another series coming up in September of 2015.

So, as we contribute periodically to this offering, let us keep in mind the young people, the cities, the different nationalities, the proclamation of our message and the need for us to give beyond the local level to sustain the work in various areas.

One of the Conference personnel who is coming in April is Elder Del Dunavant (NCC Evangelism and Church Growth). He will be sharing practical tips and insights into how to effectively use small groups to grow in spiritual health and impact our communities.
